Free One-day Positive Behavioral Supports Training – April 18, 2019 Learn Strategies for Supporting Individuals Transitioning to Community Settings

"Positive Behavioral Supports" is a one-day, regional training program open to all providers of home- and community-based services, interested in helping individuals transition to homes in community settings through Iowa's Money Follows the Person grant.

This program was developed to align with the web-based curriculum offered by the College of Direct Support, designed to train members of the direct care workforce. In addition to information on current best practices in providing behavior supports, this program will offer participants interactive, practical opportunities to apply the training to their own case studies and organizations.

Purpose: This training will focus on the foundation and skills of how to provide positive behavioral supports to individuals receiving services.

There is no charge to attend the training, and training materials will be provided by the Money Follows the Person grant. In addition, attendees will have the opportunity after the training to join a listserv (<u>behavioral-support@uiowa.edu</u>) to discuss questions or concerns in their organizations' training program and to problem solve specific cases they may be having difficulty with.
